#### 2. Eligibility and Conditions of Entry

- a. Entrants must be male professional golfers who have attained the age of 50 (fifty) years on, or before, 16th July 2009
- b. All Asian Seniors Tour professional members participating in our previous Asian Senior Masters tournaments will have first rights of entry, with priority amongst this group being given to those participating in the 2009 ASM@Malaysia in the week prior to the ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) and the remainder of the field shall be selected and their places confirmed on a first come first served basis in consultation with the respective PGAs.
- c. ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) Pro-Am events will be staged on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July 09 at Tering Bay GCC and all professional golfers wishing to contest the Final Day of the ASM @ Indonesia (Batam) must participate in both of these Pro-Am events.
- d. ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) consists Pro-Am events will be staged on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July 09 at Tering Bay GCC and all professional golfers wishing to contest the Final Day of the ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) must participate in both Pro-Am events.
- e. All professional golfers will have the opportunity to play one practice round at Tering Bay GCC on Thursday 16th July 09. Only AST Senior professionals who have confirmed their reservations for the required number of days with the ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) Official Hotel, the Purajaya Beach Resort, may avail themselves of a practice round.
- f. All professional golfers wishing to participate in the ASM@ Indonesia (Batam) are required to stay at the Purajaya Beach Resort, for a minimum of 3 (three) nights, from Thursday 16 through Sunday 19 July 2009 paying a total flat entrance fee of **SG\$ 700 which includes;**
  - i. Return ferry ticket from Singapore's Tanah Merah Ferry Terminal to the Nongsapura Ferry Terminal on Batam, Indonesian Visa on arrival and return bus transportation to and from the Nongsapura Ferry Terminal and the Purajaya Beach Resort
  - ii. 1 practice round at Tering Bay GCC on Thursday 16th July 09, and 3 ASM @ Indonesia T Shirts
  - iii. Single room from Thursday 16 through Sunday 19 July 2009 (with late check out on Sunday)
  - iv. Daily breakfast at the hotel, and lunch at Tering Bay GCC during the ASM @ Indonesia
  - v. Daily bus transportation to and from Tering Bay GCC and the Purajaya Beach Resort
  - vi. The SG\$ 100 entry fee for each senior professional golfer wishing to take part in the event.

### Eligibility and Conditions of Entry – continued .....

- g. The rate for all professional golfers' accompanying non-golfing companion(s) (spouses, caddies, etc.) is an additional SG\$ 175 per person, twin sharing, which includes return ferry tickets from Singapore to Batam, Indonesian Visa on arrival, transportation to and from the Purajaya Beach Resort, daily breakfast at the hotel, lunch at Tering Bay GCC during the 2009 ASM @ Indonesia (Batam), an invitation to the ASM @ Indonesia Welcome Dinner, and daily transportation to and from the hotel and the golf club

### 3. Conditions of Play

- a. The 2009 ASM @ Indonesia (Batam), Championship will be played over 36 holes of golf, in Stroke play format, comprising of one 18-hole round of golf on Saturday 18th and Sunday 19th July 09 being the last 2 days of the three-day tournament.
- b. The Pro-Am to be conducted on Friday 17th July 09 will be used as a practice round for professionals who may not have been able to have been able to get to Batam by Thursday 16th Jul 09 to have had a practice round.
- c. The field will be limited to a maximum 32 senior professional golfers will be eligible to play in the Championship event, with the final field being determined on a 'first come, first served' basis. **The closing date for entries shall be 10<sup>th</sup> July 09**
- d. There will **NOT BE CUT** to determine who plays in the final round on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July 09
- e. In the event of a tie for first place, a 'sudden death' play-off will be announced on hole(s) to be advised by the tournament committee.
- f. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, the US Golf Association, the Singapore Golf Association, the Asian Seniors Tour and the approved local rules of the host venue, Tering Bay Golf & Country Club.
- g. Drivers/Driving Clubs with a loft of 15 degrees or less must not have a coefficient of restitution of greater than .0830 when measured on apparatus approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews (see also Appendix II, 5a of the R&A Rules of Golf).
- h. The decision(s) of the Tournament Director of the Asian Seniors Tour, in consultation with the AST's tournament committee, shall be final, and no correspondence or arbitration shall be entered into arising from such decisions.

### 4. Prize Money

The total Prize Money shall be a minimum of **US\$ 10,000** (a sum which may well be increased) to be distributed to the top **16** professional participants (plus ties) in accordance with the results of the Championship. As the event is now to be staged in Batam, Indonesia, no withholding Tax is applicable.

### 5. Payment of Prize Money

Payment of the Prize Money to the top 10 shall be made **ONLY** by Bank Transfer, at the prevailing exchange rate, less any bank charges incurred. This could take up to 4 weeks after the completion of the event, provided your bank details are received on or by 19<sup>th</sup> July 09, payment to the remaining participants will be in cash.

### 6. Dress Code

All senior professional golfers **MUST** wear long trousers for the duration of the 2009 ASM @ Indonesia (Batam), shorts may be worn during the practice round on Thursday 16 July 09 only.
